


Suggestions for the practice of spelling words:

1. Reading for *Spelling* daily.
2. Reading for *Reading* daily.
3. Find magnetic letters that spell out each word.

4. Write each word in a stair...

L
La
Lat
Late

5. Ask your child to visualize a whiteboard in their mind. Segment the word and ask them to "write the word" on the invisible whiteboard in their mind and recite the letter names aloud (while driving around town).

6. Create letter boxes (short and tall) that correspond to the size of the word(s) that they are learning that week.  Then allow them to fill in the missing letters.

7. Write it. Stamp it. Read it. On a blank page, have your child write each word, use individual stamps to create the word and then read it

aloud. **Late** **Late** *late*

8. Practice Spelling Dictation. Say the word, use it in a sentence and repeat the word. Ask your child to "whisper" to their pencil each phonogram as they write the word on a page.

9. When writing the spelling words, write any phonograms with two or more letters in another color. **Rain**
