## **Estimated Cost**

### DRESS CODE -

\*Weather for this trip should be between 65 - 90 degrees. Possible rain showers. Most activities are outside rain or shine, please have a light-weight rain jacket or poncho available. It has rained at least one day, for the past several years. We do a lot of walking, so please be prepared with quality walking shoes.

#### Spirit Wear:

#### Business Casual:
