Paragraph III: Describe the theme, any lesson that was taught, and explain whether or not this story had any biblical themes or allusions.

Paragraph IV: Describe what you liked about the characters, plot, conflict, and setting and didn't like about the characters, plot, conflict, setting. Explain whether or not you would recommend it and to what age group. You may use first person.
